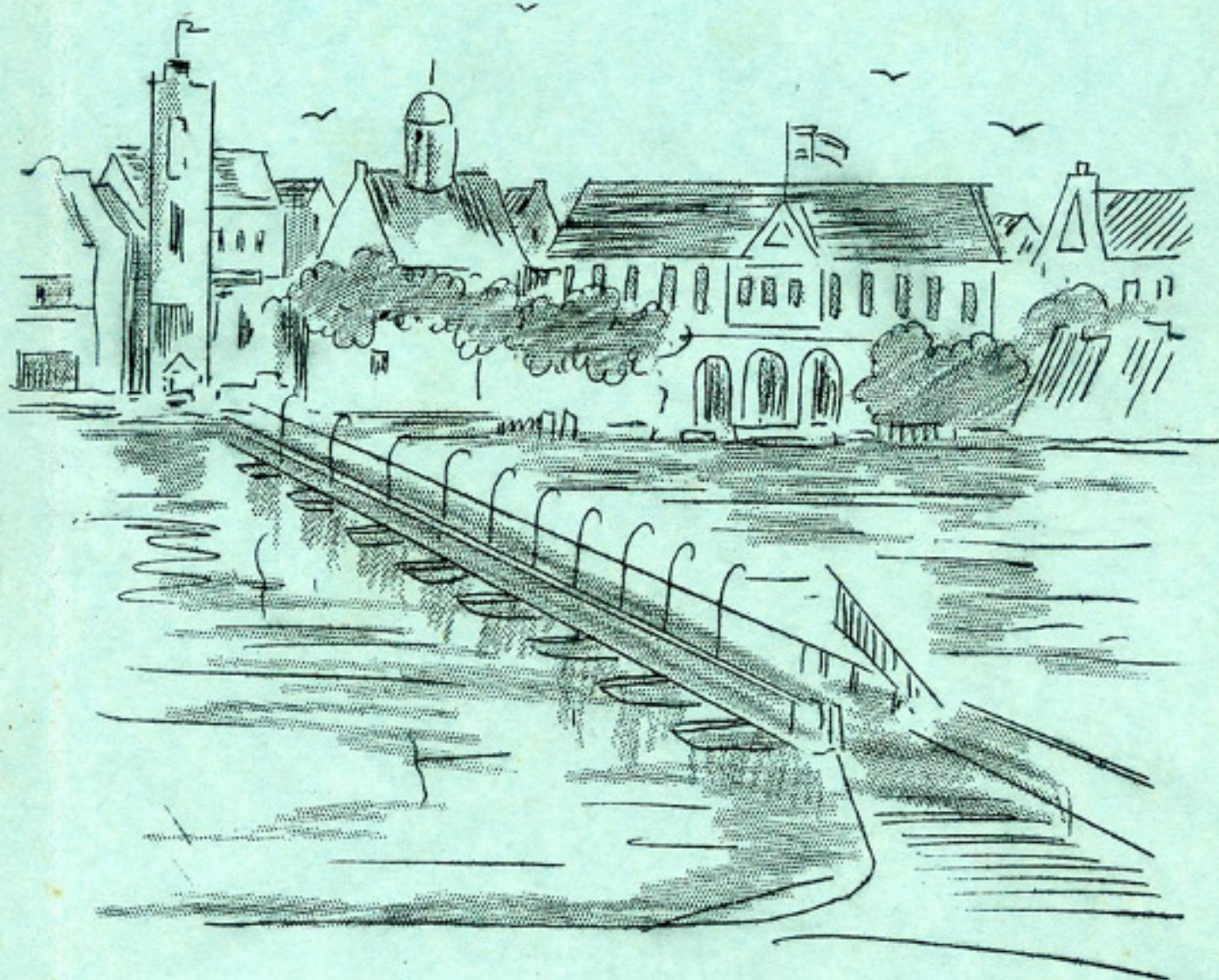
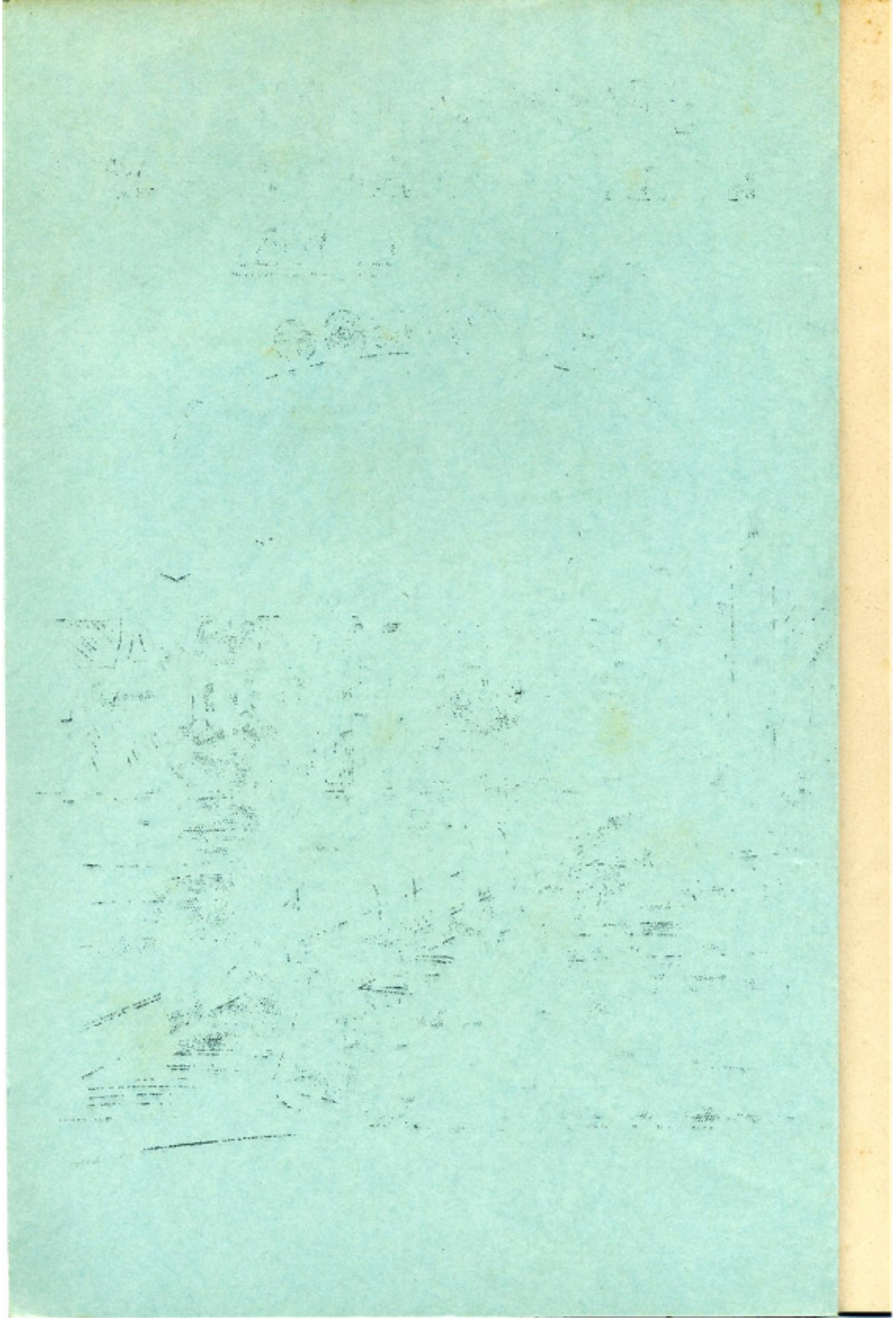

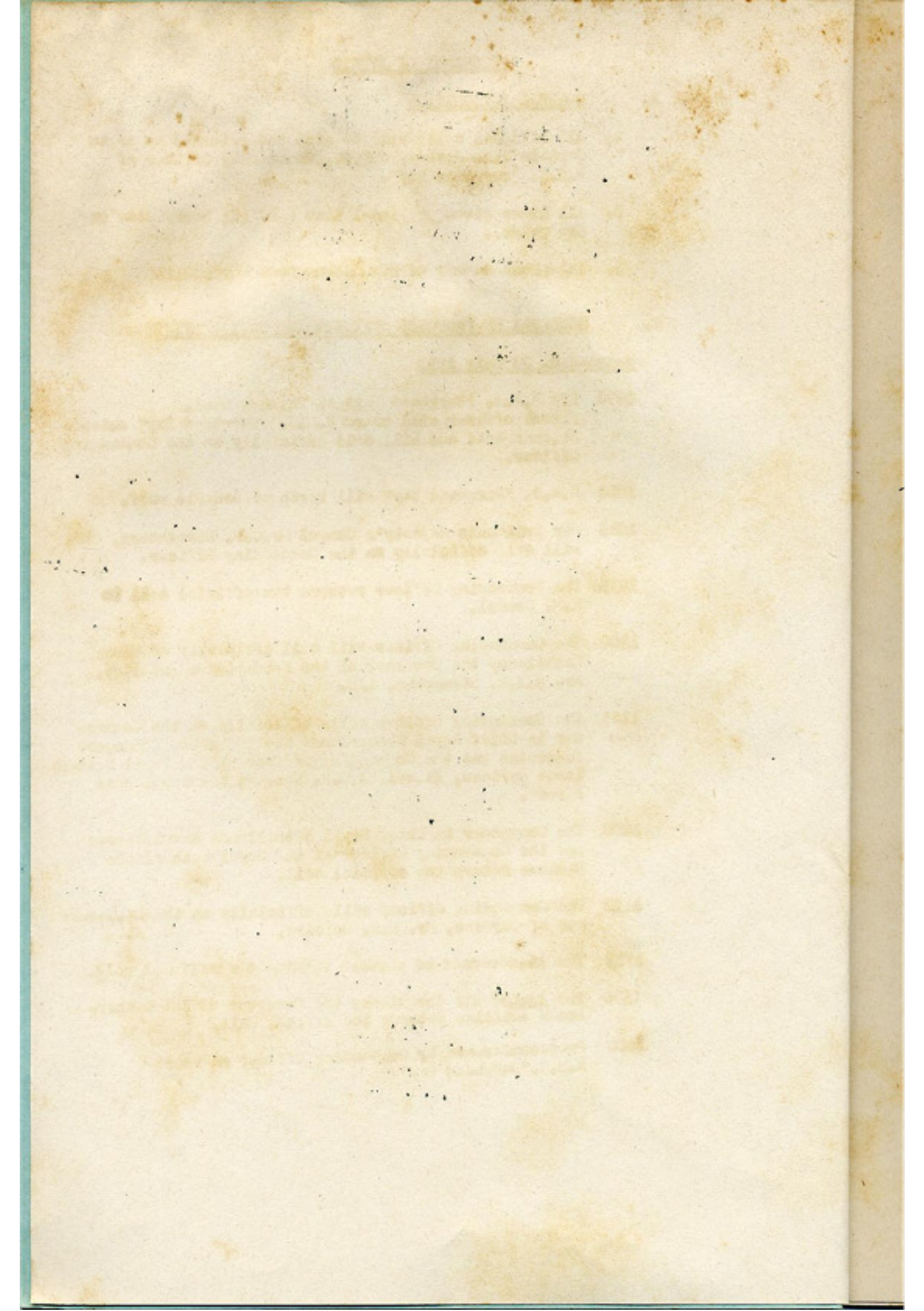
A. GENERAL INFORMATION

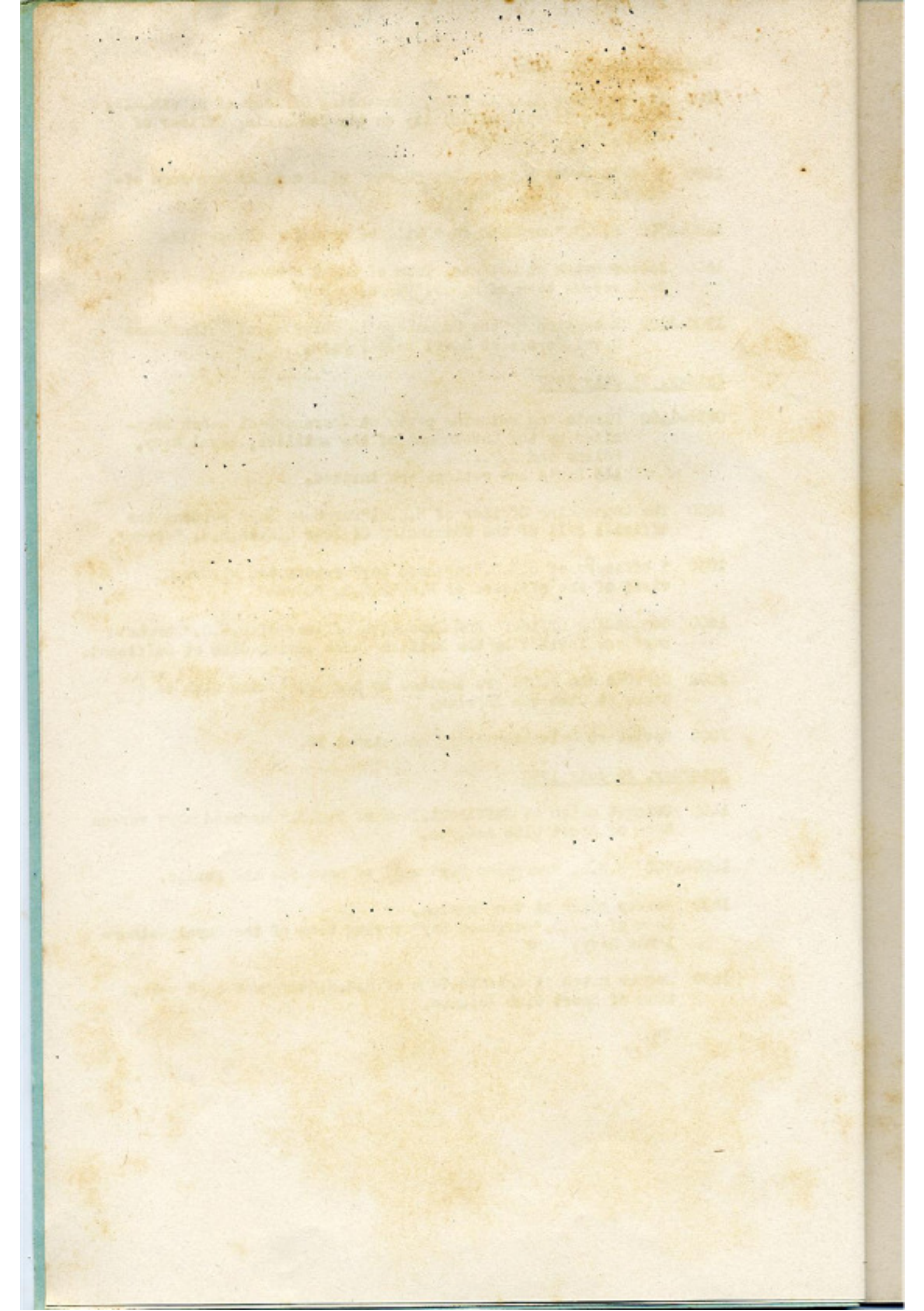

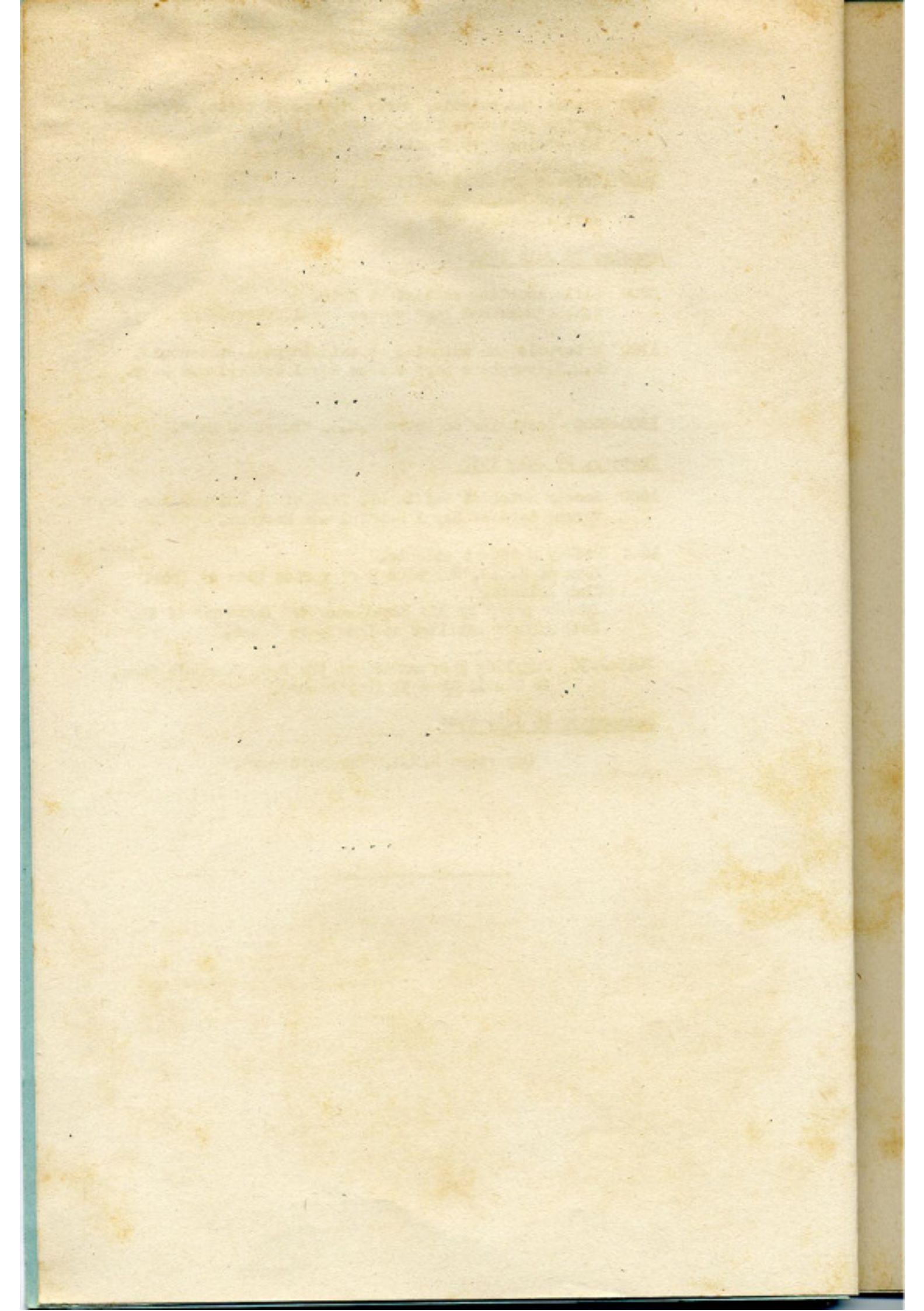

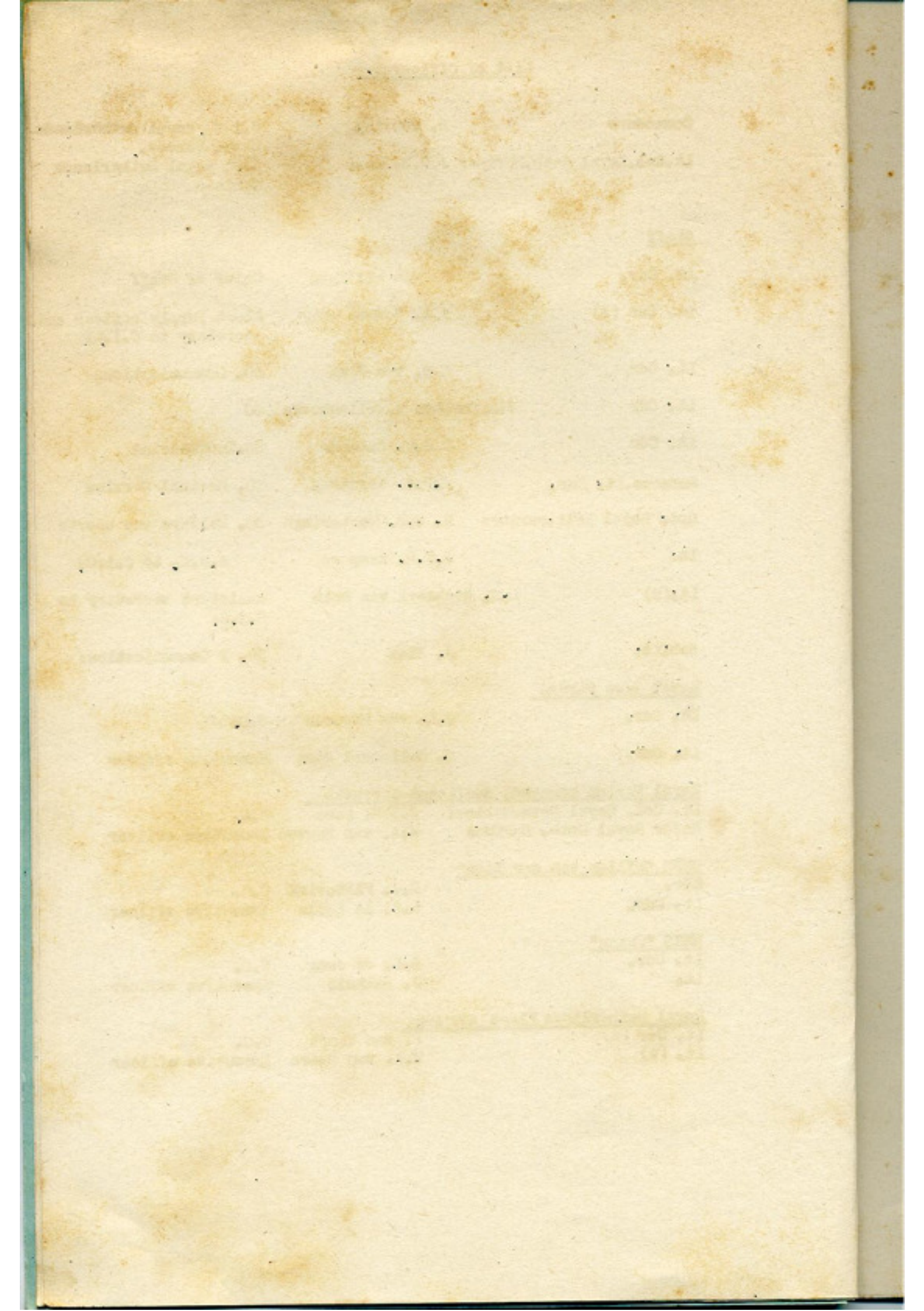
