He furthered his training with Anna Maria Pennella at the Institute of Fine Arts of Medellin, Colombia.

Mr. Martina completed his advanced studies in Europe, with Professor Richard Hauser at the Vienna Academy for Music, from which he graduated Summa Cum Laude by unanimous vote.

In 1975 Queen Juliana of the Netherlands appointed him as a Knight in the Order of Orange-Nassau.

Harold Martina has performed in Europe, the United States of America, Latin America and Japan with extraordinary acclaim by both audience and critics.
